- 7:00am - **motorcoach** arrives at **St. Andrew's United Church** to begin boarding passengers
 - a motorcoach safety briefing including the use of seat belts when available, will be completed prior to departure (always use seat belts when available and locate the emergency exits if your coach changes during your tour)
- 7:30am - depart for **Niagara-on-the-Lake** (drive time: approx. 3hrs), additional time has been allowed for traffic
- 11:00am - arrive with time to do some exploring/shopping in the area before lunch
- 12:00pm - meet at **The Shaw Club Hotel** for your **group lunch** in **Zees Grill**
- 1:30pm - make your way to the **Shaw Festival Theatre** (distance: 140m; 2 min walk) to check-in and take your seats
- 2:00pm - **The Importance of Being Earnest** begins – A Trivial Comedy for Serious People, Oscar Wilde's last and greatest play concentrates all his incredible wit and observation into a dazzling satire of Victorian attitudes. All the tricks of romantic comedy and farce are employed to present us with a portrait of the most absurd people we will ever meet – ourselves. (approx. duration: 2.25hrs)
- 4:15pm - estimated conclusion; should time allow, take some time to do some shopping in the area
- 5:15pm - board your coach and depart for **Caroline Cellars**
- 5:30pm - arrive for your **private group buffet dinner**
- 7:30pm - at the conclusion, board your coach and depart for **Chatham** (drive time: approx. 3hrs); a **driver switch** has been included on the way home to comply with driver hour regulations
